Key Questions and Facts	
What are the names of different materials?	We will learn about: wood, metal, plastic, paper, fabric, stone, glass and rubber.
Which materials are man-made and which are natural?	Man-made materials are produced, formed or made by humans. These include concrete, glass, nylon, paper, plastic and steel. Natural materials come from plants, animals or the ground. These include chalk, sand, leather, gold, cotton, coal, iron and wood.
Why are different materials suitable for different purposes?	Wood is hard and strong. Plastic can be easily moulded into different sizes and shapes. It is also waterproof. Metal is strong but it can be melted to mould to different shapes.

properties	a characteristic used to describe materials
suitability	the quality of being appropriate for a particular purpose
inventor	a person who designs or creates something that did not exist before

opaque	something that you can't see through
absorbent	the ability to soak up liquid easily
flexible	something that bends easily without breaking


