Welcome Back



Dear Parents & Carers,

I hope this letter finds you all safe and well and you have all had an enjoyable summer.

It has been wonderful to welcome all the pupils back to school this week, and welcome new pupils to our Astley Park family.

Hopefully this year will be much more settled as the situation with the pandemic stabilises.

As we move out of the restrictions, we remain cautious about the impact this will have, the last few weeks of summer term saw a rise in cases in school and an increase in class & transport bubble closures, with that in mind staff, pupils and visitors will be continuing to wear masks when entering, exiting, and moving around school. We are also continuing with twice weekly testing for staff and secondary age pupils (that have given consent). We are also continuing to operate a class bubble system, these school-based measures will continue until Friday 1st October.

In line with Government guidance, all secondary pupils will be offered two onsite tests during their first week back at school. Twice weekly testing should then continue at home until the end of September.

Secondary aged pupils were tested on Monday and will be tested again on Thursday, testing kits will come home with pupils each Friday and we would strongly encourage you to continue to test twice per week, preferably on a Sunday and a Wednesday. If your child does test positive, please contact your child's class teacher via email.

If your child tests positive they must self-isolate in line with government guidance. Identified close contacts no longer need to self-isolate but are advised to seek a PCR test. We would strongly encourage your child (if they are able to) to take a PCR if they are identified as a close contact.

I appreciate the guidance is a lot to take in and can sometimes be confusing, but we are always here to help and support, please contact a member of the business support team (BST) who will be happy to help.
