Update Letter



Dear Parents & Carers,

I hope this letter finds you all well.

I am pleased to report that Covid cases have remained low, with only one pupil case this week.

Unfortunately, we had to close a class for one day this week. I'd like to thank all the parents & carers, for their understanding and support, it was greatly appreciated.

Current Covid Measures

- All staff and secondary age pupils to continue wearing face-coverings when arriving, leaving, and moving around the school site.
- All staff engage in twice weekly testing until the end of the autumn term in December.
- All staff who are identified as a close contact will seek a PCR and engage in daily testing for 10 days.
- All secondary age pupils to continue with twice weekly testing until the end of the autumn term in December.
- All pupils who are identified as a close contact of a confirmed case are strongly encouraged to seek a PCR.
- All visitors to the school will be required to show evidence of a negative LFD test prior to arrival onsite and wear a face-covering throughout the duration of their visit.
- Assemblies will remain virtual.
- Lunches and breaktimes to continue in class bubbles.
- Educational Visits to indoor venues to restart Monday 22nd November.

We have had a great week, starting with our Odd Socks Day on Monday as we started a week of activities, focussed on "One Kind Word" raising awareness of bullying and the impact it can have.

Today is the second of three non-uniform days to support our Christmas Bingo event, your kind and generous donations of a variety of bottles today have been fantastic – thank you.

Following three days of interviews last week we have successfully recruited eight new team members, who will be starting with us in the new year. This is a huge positive and will help enormously with alleviating the staffing challenges going forward.



















I have had two meetings with the school council asking for their feedback regards how we promote & celebrate our school values. Their ideas have been amazing, and we are excited to begin to put them into practice.

We have already started on one idea; a values art display, which is currently being constructed and will be ready in the next few weeks.
