Astley Park School

Dear Parents & Carers.

I hope my letter finds you all safe and well.

Unfortunately, we needed to close Class 11R for two days this week, a decision that was not taken lightly, but necessary due to the staff team having covid. I would like to extend my sincere thanks and appreciation to the young people for coping with an unplanned change to their routine and the parents for their understanding and support.

As we enter the Autumn/Winter season, I am anticipating that we will see a resurgence of COVID and a rise in cases across the school. Government guidance remains in place for special school settings and is staff who test positive should be absent from work for 5 days and return once well enough to do so, pupils should be absent for three days and return when well enough to do so. As you can appreciate this poses a problem as pupils are able to return prior to the staff team, which will mean safely staffing the classes and keeping them open will become increasingly problematic should the numbers begin to rise.

We are continuing with our strict hand and respiratory hygiene practices to reduce the spread of the virus, however with no other measures in place in or out of school this could prove to be a challenge.
