Dear Parents/Carers,

On Wednesday 11th March, weather permitting, we will be running a community access visit to ASDA to buy something from the supermarket to bring home and to order and pay for a snack in the café. This will develop our functional maths skills and our social skills.

We kindly ask for a voluntary contribution of £5 per visit when we go to ASDA to cover the cost of something from the shop and a snack. We have mainly been practicing using coins to pay in our role-play café in class, so if you could send coins rather than notes we would really appreciate it.

Please suggest something your child could buy to bring home, that costs up to £2 (e.g. a packet of biscuits, crisps, fruit, juice etc). We will support your child to locate the item and to pay at the till. We will then choose a snack in the café, order, pay and eat it before returning to school.

We will be walking to ASDA so please send your child with a waterproof coat and warm accessories for the trip. In extremely bad weather we will stay at school.
