Sensory Story-Weather Hunt

The resources you and your child will need for this sensory story are items that can be found around your home. If you cannot find these items, you are more than welcome to find something else that will have the same impact.

WIND – in the video we used a book, but you could use a piece of cardboard, a hand-held or free-standing fan.

RAIN – in the video we used an umbrella and a spray bottle, but you could use a bowl of water and splash the water with your hands while your child wears or holds up a light-weight jacket.

SNOW – in the video we used ice and shaving foam, but you could use ice packs, cotton wool or pom poms.

THUNDER – in the video we used a musical instrument, but you could use pots and pans, banging on tables and floor or stomping your feet.

SUN – in the video we used a towel and sunglasses, but you could use a hat or just lie on the floor with your eyes closed.
