Staff Vaccinations

Lancashire Local Authority along with several others locally and nationally have recognised the importance of vaccinating staff in special schools and including them in the current wave of vaccinations I am pleased to say that vast majority of the Astley Park class teams have received their first dose of the Covid19 vaccine. This is such a positive step forward, as this will hopefully prevent the staff team from experiencing significant ill-health should they contact the virus and dramatically reduce the rate of transmission throughout school.
