Corona Virus

Dear Parents & Carers

I would like to give you further updates on the steps we are taking as a school to safeguard the health of pupils, staff and visitors in respect of the Corona Virus outbreak.

In line with the latest Government guidance we are remaining open, until we receive a directive to close.

We have however needed to implement partial closures and close five of the six Primary Classes, due to the need for staff members to self-isolate. Thank you for your support and understanding at this challenging time.

Government guidance is very clear, that pupils or staff who present with a high temperature and / or a new persistent cough should self-isolate for 7 days.

I would ask that if your son or daughter has these symptoms that they remain at home for 7 days from first noticing the symptoms and everyone else in your household then self-isolates for the recommended 14 days.

The government also issued Guidance on Social Distancing and have identified several vulnerable groups, they are advising these at-risk groups to distance themselves socially.
