Good attendance

We are closely checking every child's attendance. Please make sure you child comes to school every day. This year, all schools will be asking the council to fine parents of a child whose attendance is not good. Therefore, get your child into school every day. If your child is very sick and cannot come to school, please ring the office before 8:45am and leave a message on our answer phone. Please also make sure your child comes to school on time. School begins at 8:35am for children in Years 1 to 6 and 8:40am for Nursery and Reception. If your child waits with a teaching assistant in the playground, then they are late. Please get them to school on time. We are doing lots of things to encourage good attendance. Each week, the class with the highest



attendance will be announced in an assembly and given a trophy and the attendance bear to keep in their classroom for a week. Each child in the winning class will also be given a special certificate.

The class who have the highest attendance each month will be given a special badge to wear which they should do each day. They will need to return the attendance badge at the end of the month. We will share with you some other prizes soon.
