

## Open and honest communication

If we think your child needs extra support we will always talk to you about this

The school's arrangements for consulting with parents of children with special educational needs and involving such parents in the education of their child.

- Your child's teacher will talk to you about your child's progress at Parents' meetings or as appropriate if there are concerns about your child.
- Agreed targets and support both at school and home will be reviewed.
- If issues remain, the SENCO will be informed and asked for advice.
- A meeting will be arranged to ask you for your views
- Care Plans will be shared around your child's medical needs.
- Home – school link books will be used if appropriate to communicate with you.
- Key members of staff are available at end of school day to discuss issues.
- Strategies to support your child's learning and behaviour in school will be shared with home.
- Referrals may be made to external agencies with your permission to assess and support your child.
- You may be Signposted to other agencies e.g. Family Support workers.
- You be asked to attend Review Meetings and Annual reviews.
- You may be asked to meet with external agencies.
- You may be asked for involvement in transition meetings to ensure your child has a smooth transition.
