New school year notices September 2022

It was good to welcome you and your children back to our school last Thursday. At the start of the new school year, Mrs Rai-Moore and I are sharing with you some important announcements.

School closure for the funeral of HM Queen Elizabeth II

At the weekend, the Government announced that all schools will close for the day on Monday 19 September for the funeral of HM Queen Elizabeth II. We will reopen on Tuesday 20 September at 8:35am.

Uniform

This is important at Aston Tower and children should wear it each day. Details about our uniform can be found on the school website. You can buy a school jumper from the office or buy ones without the badge from shops. Children must wear school shoes and not wear trainers or boots to school. Children should also buy a school book bag. The office will explain how you can do this.

Trips

We will be restarting trips this year. However, these can only take place if all parents pay any costs of the trips as the school is not given any money to pay for them.

Building work

Once again, we managed to get a lot of money from the government to improve our buildings. We have replaced our fire alarm and had new fire doors fitted which make the inside of our buildings look better. 4 classrooms have been redecorated and one of our halls. Also, our roof is being replaced. This will take a time to complete. These changes continue our work to make our buildings better. This summer more than £500,000 has been spent on our school.

Attendance and coming to school on time

Your child should come to school every day unless they are very sick. Children should not have holidays in school time. The government have told us that we must fine parents who take their children on holiday during term time or miss too much school. We will be checking your child's attendance very carefully to do this. Your child also must come to school on time. Lessons start in years 1 to 6 at 8:35am so bring them to school on time. Nursery and Reception begin at 8:40am.

Homework, home reading books and the school library

Every Friday, homework will be sent out and your child should complete it over the weekend and bring it back to school on Monday. A home reading book will be sent out every Friday and your child should bring it back to school on the following Friday. Please use a school book bag to bring books to and from school. If you have still not return your child's book from last term, you will not be able to get a new one until it is returned. If a book is lost or damaged, you will be charged £5 for a new one. Reading is very important at Aston Tower an our fantastic library will open after half term.

PE and swimming

Your child's teacher will tell you the day that your child does PE. On those days, your child should come to school in their PE kit and wear it for the day. Swimming lessons have begun for children in some year groups.

Looking after resources

Everything is going up price. Teachers are talking to children about looking after school resources. Please speak to your child as well and ask them to look after school resources.

School meals

If you think your child can have free dinners, please contact the office. Please do not change between packed lunches and a school meal without telling the office first.
