Nonetheless, to ensure the safety of all ATAM families and to maintain good relations with our neighbours, I kindly request your cooperation in adhering to the following guidelines:

- 1. Avoid parking across dropped kerbs to driveways
- 2. Steer clear of fully blocking the pavement
- 3. Be considerate to everyone that has access to shared driveways
- 4. Remember when you are parking, that large emergency vehicles may need access to the street where you are parking do not block their access
- 5. Do not always expect to be able to park immediately outside the school
- 6. Do not park on double or single yellow lines
- 7. Consider neighbours who may have specific needs, for example respect disability parking bays.
- 8. Be Courteous and Patient
