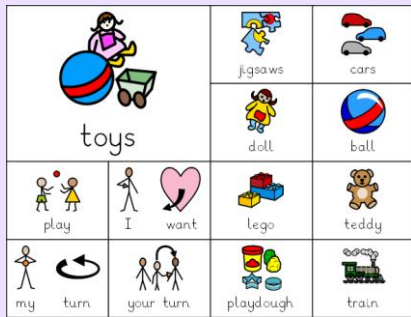

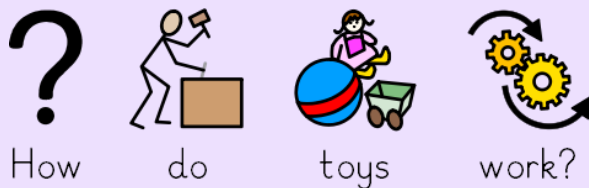

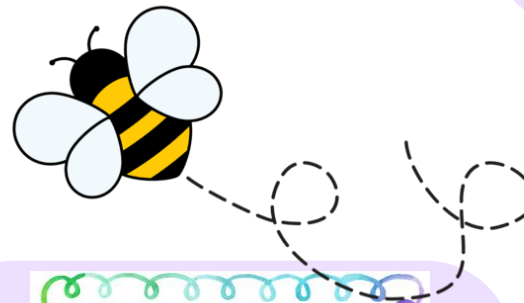
Please share any photos of your child taking part in family celebrations or events such as Halloween, Bonfire Night, Birthdays, Diwali, Eid or others.
