Summer Reading Challenge

The Summer Reading Challenge:

Significantly improves reading confidence and independence;

Ensures pupils are **ready for their return to school.** preventing the summer reading 'dip' Aids the **successful transition** between year groups and key stages

For children who took part in 2023:

80% read more over the summer holidays70% improved their reading skills72% felt more confident about their reading

How it works:

- Children sign up through their local library and receive a collector's poster.
- They set a reading goal and borrow books of their choice during the summer, collecting special stickers and incentives.
- Library staff and volunteers help children to discover new books that suit their interests and reading level and run a programme of free themed activities in the library.
- Children who complete the Challenge are presented with a certificate and a medal plus an extra special invite to a celebration event at Magna in October!
