We are really excited to start RWI and we are looking forward to telling you all about it!

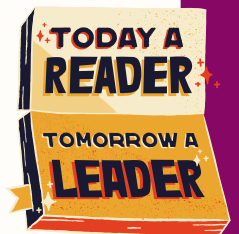
