

Pupil Premium at Badsley Primary

What is Pupil Premium?

The Pupil Premium was introduced in April 2011 and is additional funding that the government gives to schools to support children that are classed as 'disadvantaged'. Your child may be entitled to receive funding in school if they are entitled to Free School Meals, they are in care or have previously been in care.

What is the Service Premium?

The Service Premium grant is for pupils who have a parent serving or who has served in the armed services. Unlike the Pupil Premium, this grant is not solely for raising attainment but for providing additional (mainly pastoral) support. Please let us know at the school office if you believe you could qualify for this or would like any more information,



How can I apply?

Parents can apply for free school meals via the following Rotherham Council link:

You will need to provide your contact details, your partner's contact details (if applicable) and your National Insurance/NASS number.

How will Pupil Premium help my child?

Even if your child is in receipt of Universal Free School Meals because they are in the Foundation Stage or Year 1/Year 2, it is well worth applying for Pupil Premium funding. Our school can receive extra funding to support your child whilst they are in school. It may be used to deliver more interventions, allow for us to use more support staff in school, the purchase of more resources or for delivering staff training to improve the quality of teaching and learning. The additional funding may be used in order to subside experiences for your child too, such as school visits or afterschool clubs! At Badsley, our priority for spending the premium is always to improve attainment outcomes for **all** learners, to improve wellbeing and to allow for exciting and engaging experiences.
