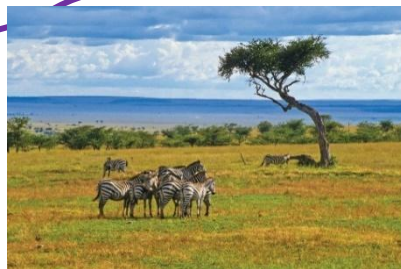
Welcome back and welcome to more daylight!

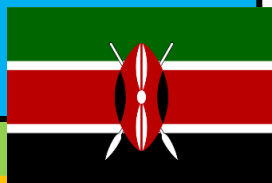
In Maths we will continue with our multiplication journey and then move on to learn division. We will continue to learn/practise our two, five and ten times tables. Can you be a times tables rock star??
