- This week, our pupils took part in Children's Mental Health Week. This year's theme is '**This is My Place**' focused on **belonging**. It explores how feeling safe, valued, and included in a "place"—whether that is a school, a home, a friendship group, or a community—is foundational to a young person's mental health.
- On Tuesday, pupils took a deep dive into the digital frontier to celebrate **Safer Internet Day**. With **Artificial Intelligence (AI)** transforming how we learn and create, this year's focus was on empowering our school community to use these tools both brilliantly and responsibly.

Young Voices is a massive educational music project that culminates in a series of high-octane arena concerts. It isn't just a "school play" on a larger stage; it is a professional production involving a live 7-piece band, backing singers, and world-class lighting.
