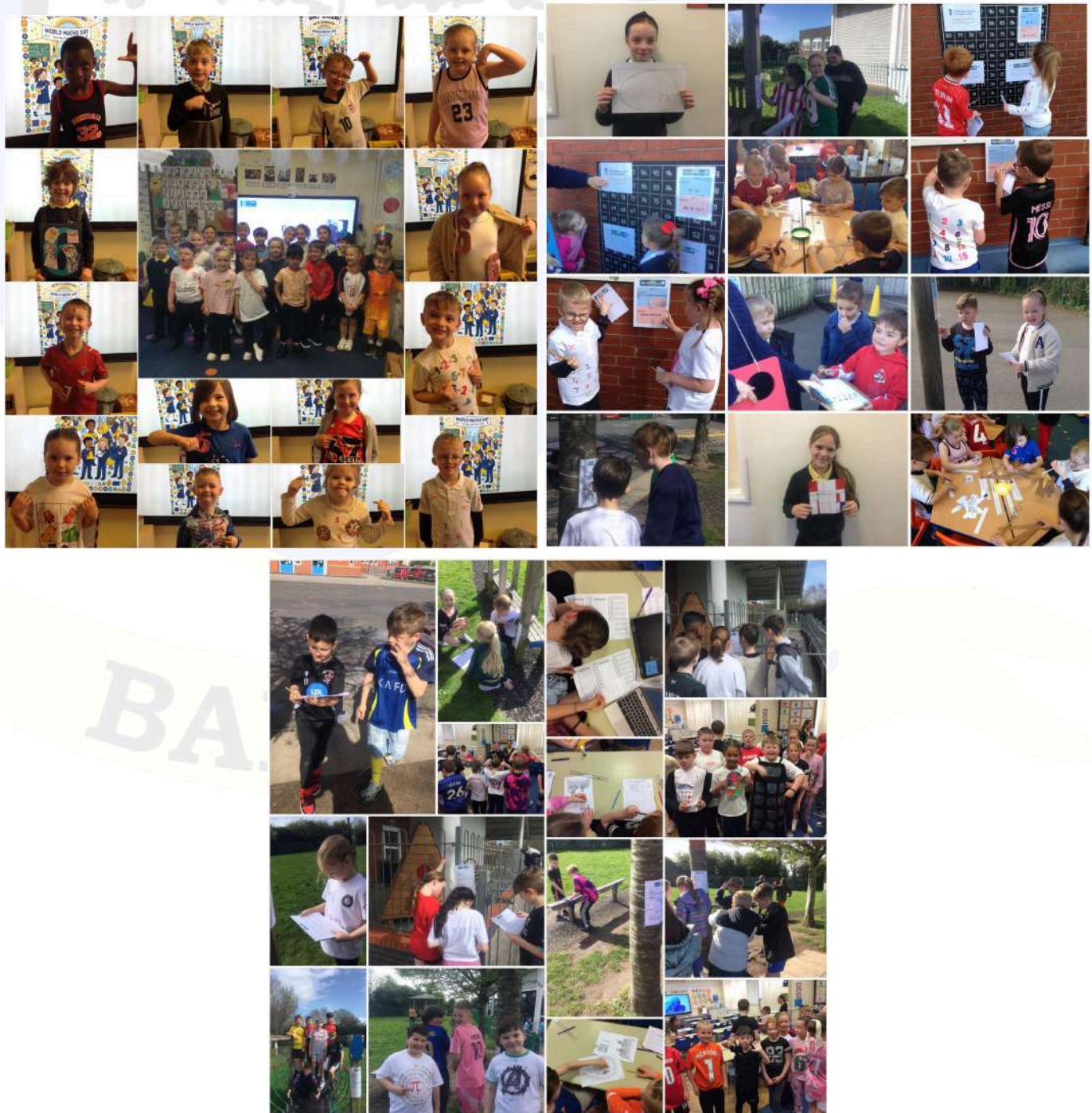
**School events this week:**
