### Class of the week: RMS

This week in RMS, the pupils have been very busy. In Literacy they have continued their traditional tale topic with the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears. Retelling the story, lots of creative activities, messy play with porridge and using the Now Press Play resource. Now Press Play" is an innovative immersive audio resource designed for primary school pupils. It's a high-tech way to take a "virtual field trip" without leaving the classroom. The children all wear a pair of headphones to listen to a high-quality, cinematic audio story narrated by professional actors, complete with sound effects and music.

In Maths, the pupils have been looking at days of the week and sequencing events. As part of the Knowledge and Understanding of the World Curriculum (KUW), the pupils have done a science experiment to see what happens to a gummy bear when it is left in water. In RE, the pupils have learned about the story of The Good Shepherd.

On Tuesday they hosted a stay and play session for two local nurseries and on Wednesday the pupils celebrated the Hindu festival of Holi by drawing round each other outside and using powder paint to decorate their outlines. **What a fantastic week RMS!**
