### English

- Persuasive texts

We will also be ensuring daily practise of spelling, Phonics and handwriting.

### Maths

In Year 2 this term, the children are expected to:

- read scales in divisions of ones, twos, fives and tens
- read the time on a clock to the nearest 15 minutes
- measure units of length, weight and mass
- handle statistics and data
- understand the position and direction of objects
- Recognise  $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $\frac{3}{4}$  of objects and numbers and solve related problems

### Curriculum

Science - To record and use data and answer questions using observations. We will be focusing on Animals including Humans and Plants.

Humanities - History - Explorers - Scott of the Antarctic

RE - The Bible – Why is it such a special book?

*Non-Christian faith link – Do people of other faiths have holy books?*

PE - Our topics this term are athletics and striking and fielding.

Computing - We will be learning how to use coding

Music - We will be exploring a unit called 'Reflect, Rewind, Replay', and different genres of music.

Art - We will be making 3D models. We will also be exhibiting our work as part of a gallery.

DT - We will be making puppets in textiles.

### Homework

Homework will continue to be set on Google Classroom on Friday afternoons, due on the following Wednesday. This will include an online Maths activity on Active Learn Primary (Power Maths).  
Please continue to use TT Rockstars and Numbots.

Our designated PE day this half term is Monday. Please ensure that you have your PE kit in school, earrings are removed and long hair tied back on this day.

### Reading

In addition to any homework tasks you can also support your child by listening to them read as often as possible with an expectation of three times per week. Children have the opportunity to change their books on a Monday morning by placing them into the class basket. Each pupil has a reading challenge sheet, in which they work towards earning reward badges.
