



Curriculum Information

1/2JB - Summer Term

English

We will explore texts of different types, including:

- Traditional Tales
- Traditional Rhymes
- Instructions
- Stories with familiar settings

We will also be ensuring daily practise of spelling, Phonics and handwriting.

Maths

This term, the children are expected to:

- measure units of length, weight and mass
- understand the position and direction of objects
- recognise and use coins and notes
- use different coins to make the same amount
- read the time on a clock - o'clock and half past (Y1)
- read the time on a clock to the nearest 15 minutes (Y2)

Curriculum

Science - To record and use data and answer questions using observations. We will be focusing on Plants, Animals Including Humans and Materials.

Humanities - To compare life in Kenya to life in Blackpool, looking at the climate, weather, the food they eat and how they go to school. After half term we will learn about a significant explorer.

RE - To learn why the bible is a special book to Christians and about other faith's special books.

PE - Our topics this term are athletics and striking and fielding.

Computing - We will be creating animated story books and learning how to code.

Art - We will be making birds with different media.

DT - To make a puppet using textiles, following the design, make, evaluate process.

Homework

Homework will continue to be set on Google Classroom on Friday afternoons, due on the following Wednesday.

For English, the children will have a variety of different activities based on the English text book. Year 2 children will include pages from the white SPAG books. Maths homework will be computer based on My Maths. Spelling tests will be on a Friday and times tables test will be done three times a week.

PE Days

Our designated PE days this half term are Monday(indoor) and Thursday(outdoor). Please ensure that you have your PE kit in school, earrings are removed and long hair tied back on this day.

Reading

In addition to any homework tasks you can also support your child by listening to them read as often as possible, but they need to have their record signed at least three times. Children have the opportunity to change their books once a week. Please could books be in school every day, to allow us to read with your children too.
