Welcome back: Happy New Year!

I hope that you all were able to spend time with loved ones and friends at some point over Christmas. For everyone, it was another year where we have had to be extra careful, ensuring that we look after those dearest to us, as well as ourselves, as the virus continues to infect people.

At the moment, Baines' has ten staff and seventeen children off ill with Covid; reminding us that some of our Covid safety procedures must continue. Currently, we are able to continue to operate, however if numbers rise amongst staff, it may become difficult to keep all classes open. If staff are ill and we are unable to cover them internally or through supply, I may need to send a class home. If this does happen, online learning is ready to begin for any class that requires it. I am hoping that we are not forced into this situation, because educating your children in the school and nursery buildings will always be our preferred choice.

This half term we are focusing on the value of Courage. The importance of friendship and kindness, to help each other be brave, is something that we will be talking about in school. Please talk to your children about what being courageous means to them and whether they find it easy to be brave.

Covid Update

As you may be aware, the advice around testing for Covid has changed. If your child experiences any cold-like symptoms such as a runny nose, temperature or cough, please keep them at home and test them using a LFD test. If they test positive they must self-isolate for up to ten days. If your child tests negative on two separate tests taken twenty-four hours apart on days 6 and 7, please contact school/nursery to discuss them returning earlier than ten days.
