## Baines' Endowed Parents, Teachers and Friends Association (PTFA)

A fundraising chart will be placed on the playground with our target amount listed, so that all parents/carers can stay up-to-date with our fundraising efforts. Hopefully, through working together, we will be able to achieve our goal: to get something extra for your children.

## **New Newsletter Format**

## **Payment for School Trips**

This year, understandably, some families have found it more difficult to pay for school trips. To help, in September, all parents/carers will be able to pay on ParentPay for trips from the start of the year. A letter will be sent out in September with more details of this new system. A total lump sum will be set for the two trips that parents/carers are asked to contribute to and any change left, will be refunded. School will continue to provide one Unique Experience trip for each child, which is funded through the P.E. Grant. Please note that the Academy does not receive any funding in the school budget from the government, for school trips. Our office is also cashless, so we are unable to 'lend' money to parents for any purpose.

## **ParentApp**

Our Academy will continue to use Parentapp as our main platform for communicating with parents: messages, letters and newsletters will all come via Parentapp; all parents/carers will need this app on their phones. Any parents/carers who still require a paper copy can come into the office to ask for a print out.

## Before and After School Wraparound Care

Please remember that it is essential that your child is brought to the doors to be dropped off at Early Birds to ensure their safety. We have now returned to our pre-pandemic routine of parents/carers signing their children in and out again. This practice strengthens our safeguarding procedures at Early Birds and Bridges.

## Safeguarding

We are constantly dealing with issues that occur over digital devices outside of academy hours. Please ensure that your children are accessing age appropriate applications/platforms and that you are monitoring the way they behave whilst on them. Our website has various guides to support you in managing your children's access and parental controls. There are also links to various other websites that can help you.

#### **Attendance**

Our whole academy attendance is at **93%** (**12th July**). This is compared to National attendance figures which last Thursday, 12th July, stood at **86.9%**. Before the Covid 19 pandemic our attendance figures were always between 95% and 97%. It is our aim to be back at those percentages or preferably even higher. Our academy attendance is monitored fortnightly by the local authority and not only for the absences but also the types of absences and it is essential you inform us of the reasons for your child's absence to ensure we code the class registers correctly. We appreciate your support with this important matter. Please check the academy attendance management policy for full details.

#### Uniform

<u>Please ensure that your child is wearing the correct school uniform on their return to school in</u> September, including appropriate shoes and their ALWAYS badge.

Should any family require any assistance with uniform, please contact Miss Sawyer, Mr Walton or Mrs Duckworth at school, as we may be able to help.

School will be collecting any outgrown, good quality uniform and offering it out again during the summer holidays for anyone who would like it. Please donate any clean, good quality uniform, shoes or pumps during the first week of the summer holidays.

If you would like any spare uniform you are welcome to come to school on Tuesday 2nd August between 9am and 3pm to see if we have any items of use to you. There will be no charge for any items.
