I would like to thank all of our families for supporting school and nursery, through what has been an extremely challenging start to the new school year. Myself and my team at Baines' appreciate the support, patience and understanding from all of our parents and carers. I am happy to report that, as we end this week, the number of positive cases in school has dropped significantly and is now into single figures; most pupils and staff affected are due to return to the Academy next week.

As an Academy, we will continue to wear masks on site in communal areas, socially distance where possible, promote regular and careful handwashing for a minimum of twenty seconds and continue to provide hand sanitiser for use in school and nursery.

The following symptoms are now associated with Covid:

School Photographs

Bikeability Year 6 Catch Up: 5th & 6th and 13th & 14th October

Letters have been sent home with Year 6 pupils and a Parentapp message has also been sent to parents/carers. Children have been allocated either 5th and 6th October OR 13th and 14th October.

Children will need to bring their bikes, helmets, and bike lock, if they have one, to the school gates near the Year 5 Entrance Door and collect from the same gates at the end of the school day. Bikes cannot be left in school overnight for security reasons.

This is due to the current Covid situation in Blackpool and the need to make an accurate risk assessment nearer to the date.

Primary School Applications for September 2022

If you have, or know anyone who has, a child who was born between 1st September 2017 and 31st August 2018, you must apply for a Primary School Reception place for September 2022. Applications for Primary School must be received by 15th January 2022. Places are allocated by schools and academies by 4th March and parents are informed of their place by 16th April. If you or anyone you know needs to apply, please apply online via the applications portal, or request a paper application from the Council.

Secondary School Applications

Please check your preferred secondary school website for details of their Open Days, or telephone their school office to make an enquiry. Please be aware that **the deadline for applying for a Blackpool secondary school for September 2022**, **is 31st October 2021**. If you apply later than this date, you are at risk of not getting a place at your preferred school. Please DO NOT APPLY LATE.

Harvest Appeal 2021

This year we will celebrate Harvest internally in school: Year 2 will lead our Key Stage 1 Harvest Assembly on Wednesday 6th October and Year 5 will lead the Key Stage 2 Harvest Assembly on Tuesday 6th October.

Our School Councillors have chosen Emmie's Kitchen as their charity for this Harvest. Emmie's Kitchen was created when Emmie Narayn-Nicholas was diagnosed with leukemia, aged 8, back in 2018. Her family members came to spend a great deal of time in Royal Manchester Children's Hospital, which is a hospital that has treated some of our children at Baines'. It became very apparent to Emmie's family, that the availability of tasty, nutritious homemade meals and snacks to nourish the family during their long days on the ward, was extremely limited, so they cooked up the idea for 'Emmie's Kitchen'.

Once a month, Emmie's Kitchen prepares delicious, homemade three course meals for families staying at Manchester House to be served in their communal kitchens by committed volunteers. These special evenings are a highlight for parents and visitors, who are treated to table service and the chance to meet and socialise with others; a few hours of well-deserved respite. Regardless of the issues caused by the pandemic, they have continued to provide food for families by delivering meals from established local restaurants and snack bags.

Parentpay has been set up to take donations online from any parents/carers who are able to make a contribution to Emmie's Kitchen. Donations should be received by Wednesday 20th October; the total raised will be shared with you all in our November Newsletter. Pastoral Team Update

The Pastoral Team are working tirelessly in school to support the children and their families in lots of ways. Sometimes we will work with children that are struggling with bereavement, with those children who may need a little extra nurture and sometimes children who need support to manage school routines and expectations. We may work with small groups of children or on a 1:1 basis depending on their needs at the time.

One of the ways we monitor how children are managing is by using Dojos. We are currently trialling a different approach with Dojos and will send a separate letter out via ParentApp to explain this and the procedures we use in school to identify and support the children.

Youth Empowerment Forum

Three children in Year Six have been selected to represent Baines' Endowed at the Youth Empowerment Forum.
