#### English

Our units of study this term are:

- Fairytales
- Information texts
- Themed Poems
- Traditional tales with a twist

#### Maths

This term we will be focussing on:

- Begin to recall multiplication and division facts for 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Recognise, make and partition numbers to 100
- Addition and subtraction with numbers to 100.

#### Curriculum

Our topics for this term are:

**Science** - To make careful observations to answer a question. This term we will be focussing on Living things in their habitat.

**Humanities** - To know about the local area (Geography) and the Great Fire of London (History).

**RE** - Harvest (including how Jews celebrate Harvest), Why was Jesus special and Christmas.

**PE** - Our topics this term are dance and games.

**Computing** - We will be exploring internet safety and looking at technology outside of school.

**Art and DT** - Spirals (Art) and creating a moving picture (DT)

#### Additional Support

All pupils have access to Purple Mash, TT Rockstars and Numbots. These can be accessed using their unique login details, stuck in the front of the blue homework books.

#### Homework

Homework will be set online (Google Classroom) on Friday and should be returned to school/completed by the following Wednesday. Spelling tests will be on a Friday and times tables completed in Maths lessons on Monday, Wednesday and Friday as part of a quick warm up activity. Spelling lists will be given out every half term and kept at home to practise. Additional homework will be provided throughout the school year, including research based projects.

#### PE Days

Our designated PE days this half term are Monday and Thursday. Please ensure that you have your PE kit in school, earrings are removed and long hair tied back on this day.

#### Reading

In addition to any homework tasks you can also support your child by listening to them read as often as possible but need to have their record signed at least three times. Children have the opportunity to change their books on a Monday by placing them into the class basket. Throughout the week, children will complete an online quiz on their book to ensure they can comprehend what they are reading. Reading books are to be brought into school every day.
