Maths

In Year 1 this term, the children will cover a range of

- Number Place value
- Number Addition and Subtraction
- Measurement Length and Height
- Measurement Mass and Volume

Curriculum

Science - We will explore different materials and their uses and we will observe the seasonal change from Winter to Spring.

History- We will learn about the moon landing, using Neil Armstrong as a significant person.

RE - We will talk about our favourite things that God created. We will also look at other religions and what people of Muslim and Hindu faith believe about how God made the world. After half term we will learn about Easter and how Jesus died on the cross and rose again.

PE - We will explore how to move and dance like robots. We will improve our skills of catching, throwing and hitting a ball.

Computing - After half term we will be looking at online safety.

DT - After half term we will be looking at mechanisms. We will be making our own vehicles that include wheels and axles.

Art - We will be exploring the world through Monoprint Surface and Colour.
