Year 6

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back. We hope you were able to have an enjoyable summer. We are extremely happy to see our Baines' pupils back in school and we have lots of exciting learning ready for your children this year.

Our subjects and their topics for this term are:

Maths - Number, Statistics, Measurements and Geometry.

English - Writing outcomes: Narrative and Balanced Argument.

Science – Living Things and their Habitats and Evolution and Inheritance.

R.E. - Is every person's journey the same? and Our Non-Christian Faith Unit: Pilgrimage

History - What happened to the Mayans?

Geography - Fair Trade.

PSHCE – Relationships: Families and friendships, Safe relationships and Respecting ourselves and others.

P.E. - Our designated PE days this term are **Tuesday and Friday**. Please ensure that PE kit is in school, and long hair is fully tied back on these days.

PE Kit should consist of: a yellow t-shirt (different to the one they are wearing that day) and blue shorts or tracksuit bottoms. Depending on weather we may be indoor or outdoor; pupils need to have suitable footwear in school – pumps/bare feet for indoor and trainers for outdoor.

PE is part of the National Curriculum and all children are expected to take part. If your child is unable to participate please send a note in to your child's class teacher.

This term, your child will be experiencing Dance, Gymnastics and Invasion Games.

SATs

Throughout the year, we will be preparing for the end of Key Stage 2 SATs tests. In order for you to help your child at home, we will aim to give you as much information as possible; if you have any questions, please do not hesitate to ask us.

Homework

Maths homework will mainly be completed on PowerMaths and will focus on what has been learnt in the week. This will be set on a Friday, and should be completed by the following Tuesday.

For English, your child is expected to read to an adult at least three times a week. They should also practice their weekly spellings for the Spelling Test, which will take place on a Friday.

Spelling lists will be given out every half term, as well as being uploaded onto the Google Classroom.
