English

Our units of study this term are:

RE - We will talk about our favourite things that God created. We will also look at other religions and what people of Muslim and Hindu faith believe about how God made the world. After half term we will learn about Easter and discuss what the most important part of the story is.

History - The moon landing and Neil Armstrong

Art/DT - Creating vehicles using wheels and axles and exploring monoprint surface and colour

PE - Gymnastics and Games (Rolling a ball)

Computing - After half term we will be looking at online safety and animated story books .

Homework

This year we will be using google classroom to set our homework and sheets provided in red homework books. It will be set on a Friday and should be completed and returned by the following Friday morning. .

Maths homework will either be computer based using their Power Maths log in OR a maths activity. English homework may be phonics or basic skills practice.

Topic Projects will also be set for the half term.
