



PE and sport premium allocation for the current academic year 2016-17 is £10,045

How we plan to spend this year's allocated PE and Sports Premium Grant:

- Blackpool Children's Service: Sport 4 Champions in Y6
- FA Soccer Skills: working with all Year 6 pupils
- Staff training by external professionals
- Transport to competitions, festivals and Inclusive sports events
- Blackpool F.C. Community Trust: 'FIT2GO' in Year 4
- Blackpool F.C. Community Trust: 'Reading the Game' working on writing with Year 6
- Blackpool Children's Service: Early Years Physical Activity for EYFS
- Blackpool Children's Service: Curriculum support in KS1 and KS2
- After school sport clubs for KS1 and KS2 pupils:
- AUTUMN: Multi-skills in Year 1 and Year 4
- SPRING: Football in Year 2 and Year 3
- SUMMER: Cricket Years 5 & 6, and Athletics Years 1 & 2

How last year's funding made a difference to the PE and sport participation:

- The standard of PE teaching has continued to improve across the school
- Fully inclusive PE lessons
- 98% of pupils said they liked PE, knew what they were learning in lessons and that their teacher helped them to get better at PE
- A range of after school clubs provided by the school – including football, multi-skills, athletics & cricket
- More pupils taking part in competitive sport
- Over 85 pupils, from EYFS to Year 6, took part in Blackpool School Games
