## Early Years Pupil Premium

This is additional money given to early years settings for certain groups of children:

- ❖ Looked After Children
- ❖ Disadvantaged 3 and 4 year olds (parents in receipt of certain benefits/allowances)

Baines' Nursery received **£1,958.43** Early Years Pupil Premium in 2015-16, so how have we spent it?



Training for staff in supporting early language development. **almost £200**



Support to reduce the cost of the trips for specific pupils. **around £200**



Resources to support specific areas of need for individual children. **almost £160**

## ...and the impact?

- 🌍 All eligible children made progress and 50% made accelerated progress, moving to age related expectations (ARE) with 1 child moving to above ARE in the area of listening. We saw similar progress in speaking & in understanding 1 child moved from well below to meet ARE.
- 🌍 In physical development (moving and handling) 71% of boys and 76% of girls met the age related expectation (it was 64% for boys and 69% for girls) so the gap has narrowed.
- 🌍 Individual children made at least average progress and in some areas accelerated progress.

In 2016-17 we hope to receive a similar amount of Early Years Pupil Premium, we plan to:

- ❖ Continue using Communicate and the Talk Boost programme to support speech and language development
- ❖ Purchase additional role play resources.
- ❖ Improve access to technology within the nursery.

- ❖ Provide ongoing training for staff.
