

# Pupil Premium

## Future Plans for 2015-16

Pupil Premium is additional money given to schools to support certain groups of children:

- ❖ Looked After Children
- ❖ Children who have been eligible for Free School Meals at any point in the last 6 years.

In 2014-15 Baines' we received **£197.600** in Pupil Premium funding. It is likely to be a similar amount in 2015-16, so what are we intending to spend this money on?

- Additional Speech and Language Therapy for identified children.
- Educational Psychologist and Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator time.
- Additional Pupil Welfare support to manage attendance and punctuality.
- Additional teacher supporting phonics in Y1 and English and maths in Y2.
- Additional teacher supporting English and maths in Y3 and Y4.
- A part time family support worker, to support families and children in need.
- Additional teaching assistants in Y5 and Y6, so each set has a TA.
- A structured intervention programme led by teachers/TAs across the school.
- One to one tuition for identified children.
- Increased behaviour support across the school.
- Music tuition for identified children.
- Extra curricular activities for eligible children.
- Subsidised school trips and residential visit.
- Reducing the price of netbooks in Y6.
- Additional resources to support English, maths and the more able.
- Additional books to broaden the available range in the library.
