OUR RESULTS 2016

A new, more challenging curriculum was introduced in 2015 and assessed for the first time this summer. These tables compare the results we achieved in May 2016 with National results. 2016 also saw the introduction of a new system of assessing progress and so results to the previous year are not completely comparable. However we have taken the age related expectation from each system to make a simple comparison

We are particularly proud of how well the children attained in writing where we ended the year well above National Averages. We are also delighted that our more able children (working at greater depth) made great progress as we were above National Averages at greater depth in both reading and maths. Our KS1 results represent good progress, as children tend to join our school just below National averages.

We are really proud of how well our Year 6 children did this year; new tests and a much more challenging curriculum and yet we were close to national averages in EGPS and above in writing and maths. We were particularly pleased with our attainment in maths, 6% above the national average is a real achievement. Of some concern our reading results and the percentage of more able children who were working at greater depth, where we remained below national averages and our results didn't reflect the hard work put in by both children and staff.
