Year 6 KS2 SATs

Our children have achieved strong results at the Expected Standard, particularly in Reading. Well done to them all and thank you for your support as parents.

EXS is the Expected Standard for Year 6. EXS+ includes children who reached the Higher Standard (HS) in Reading and/or Maths, or Greater Depth (GD) in Writing.

The Writing result is from teacher assessment as there is no Writing SAT test.

GPS: Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling

Combined: a child has to achieve EXS in Reading, Writing *and* Maths.

For Combined GD/HS, the child has to achieve GD/HS in Reading, Writing *and* Maths.

GD (Greater Depth) for Reading and Maths is based on a scaled score of 110.

The scaled scores are like an average, with 100 being the expected standard.

Year 6 KS2 Progress Measures

Progress for Reading is in-line with the national average. Progress in maths this year is below national average: maths will be a priority on our School Improvement Plan this year.

Year 2 KS1 teacher assessments

All the results are above the 2023 national averages.

The children took the Year 2 national tests and their results are reflected in these teacher assessments.
