The Good Level of Development is when pupils achieve the Expected Standard in the Prime Areas plus Literacy and Numeracy.

Notes re KS2 (Y6) results

EXS is the Expected Standard for Year 6. EXS+ includes children who reached the Higher Standard (HS) in Reading and/or Maths, or Greater Depth (GD) in Writing.

The Writing result is from teacher assessment as there is no Writing SAT test. GPS: Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling

Combined: a child has to achieve EXS in Reading, Writing *and* Maths.

For Combined GD/HS, the child has to achieve GD/HS in Reading, Writing *and* Maths. GD (Greater Depth) for Reading and Maths is based on a scaled score of 110.

The scaled scores are like an average, with 100 being the expected standard.
