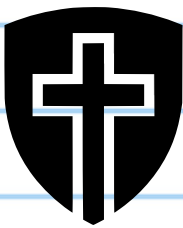
We will be looking at structures and making our own pencil pots!

We will be learning about Judaism and Christianity.



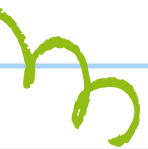
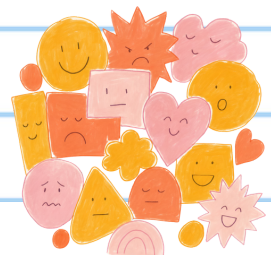
History/Geography
