Reading:

Please continue to support your child at home by **reading daily for 5-10 minutes**.

This really does make a huge difference and greatly develops the children's confidence and love of books from a young age. When you have listened to your child read, please log this on Boom reader.



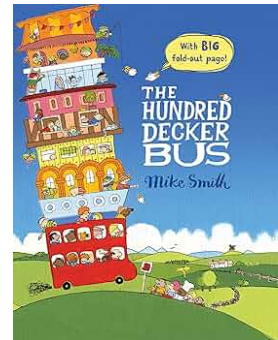
