

School Buses : School buses run from (a) the Ribble Bus Station, Tithebarn Street, Preston, at 8-10 a.m. (S18) via Bamber Bridge; at 8-20 a.m. (S12) via Leyland Road, Penwortham, (S25) via Cop Lane, Penwortham; and from (b) the Ribble Bus Station, Chorley at 8-25 a.m., daily, picking up pupils en route. The return buses leave the School gates at 4-8 p.m. and a School bus for Wroughtington via Eccleston at 4-5 p.m. daily.
