

To reach your Target Grade in Art you will need to complete the following:

1. Finish all coursework and examination preparatory sheets (sculptures and large acrylic paintings must be included, especially for those aiming to achieve a level 4 or above).

2. All observational drawings are detailed, demonstrating most of the art elements listed below:

Line

Tone - Use a wide variety of shades of grey/colour, including white highlights.

Texture- Use a range of mark making techniques to represent the feel of the object e.g. metal, wood, cloth.

3. All coursework looks complete or a focal point has been emphasised (the image fades towards the edges).

4. Try not to leave too many white backgrounds on drawings.

5. Complete written evaluations for coursework and examination studies.

In most projects, please provide evidence of how your work links to an artist's or art movement e.g. Georgia O'Keeffe, Cubism.

Use homework/revision time to write up notes and finish preparation sheets.
