Mental Health Family Hour - Suicide prevention

This Thursday (4<sup>th</sup>) at 10am, the Mental Health Family Hour will be returning to talk about suicide prevention. This episode may be triggering for some people, as we will be talking about suicide and attempted suicide. We are going to be joined by three guests, one of which will be sharing his story of attempting to take his own life. Myself and Dave have both personally been impacted by suicide and it is extremely important that we open up the conversation about this. If anything does upset you when watching this, please do email me following the episode. We will also be signposting to all available services and this will also be in the YouTube description too. We will also talk about what we can do as individuals to help prevent people taking their own life, what is already out there in the community and some statistics.
