Dear Parent/Carer

As we approach the end of term, I wanted to remind you of our uniform and appearance policy if you are getting ready to purchase new items for your son or daughter. We pride ourselves as a school on our high standards of uniform and appearance of all our children and wish to maintain these standards moving forward. There have been **no changes** to our uniform and appearance policy in light of Covid 19 and our current policy is attached. Please take the time to read it through in order that all students meet our expectations. Please could we ask that your child does not return to school in September in an item of clothing or footwear that is not allowed as we want to start the term on a positive note.

Could I please draw your attention to the section on shoes and footwear not allowed, the length of kilts which must be at knee length and the correct school trousers. If in doubt about any footwear please do not purchase as any incorrect footwear will need to be replaced.

I would also like to remind all parents and students that false tan, acrylic nails and false eyelashes are not part of our expected uniform and appearance policy and we would encourage students not to return to school with any of these in September. This also applies to piercings and we would encourage any child having a piercing done to get it done at the start of the summer break, so that they have six weeks for it to heal and they can take it out for when we start back at school in September. No piercings including piercings covered with plasters are allowed. Finally, could I ask that you please check our section on hairstyles and extreme hair cuts and what is and is not allowed.

May I finally take this opportunity to wish you and your child a happy, safe and joyous summer break and we all look forward to seeing all our children again in September for the start of a new school year.
