### **Home Education Information**

In the event of an individual child having to be at home under COVID guidelines, the child will be sent the relevant work at the end of each school day.

If, for example, half the class are self-isolating and half the class are in school, the teacher will teach the children in school as normal, and provide work at home on a daily basis for the children working at home.

If the whole class bubble is not in school, the teacher will provide a daily video message to the children regarding the learning for the day, and appropriate tasks. (this will vary day to day and year group to year group). If the class teacher is ill/showing symptoms and is unable to provide work, work will be provided by another member of the teaching staff. There will be individual email communication once a week from the class teacher or another member of staff.

If your child's class bubble has been sent home, the child is not allowed on the school premises to collect/ drop off a sibling.

There are so many different scenarios and we may need to adjust as we go along. Should we be faced with such decisions, we will take the advice from Public Health England.
