Jubilee Celebrations Day Friday 27th May

We have an exciting day planned for our "Jubilee Celebrations Day" next Friday. This will be a non-uniform day, so please send your child to school in something red, white or blue, or all three colours if you wish!

The events we have planned for the day are as follows. The day will start with the children gathering together to learn facts about the Queen and what a jubilee is. Each class, throughout the day will plant a jubilee tree in the school grounds to commemorate the occasion. Children will make jubilee placemats, crowns and/or design a special jubilee postage stamp throughout the day. There will be a prize for each class for the best designs. At lunch time, the children will have a whole school picnic (weather permitting) and enjoy a buffet lunch.

In the afternoon, parents and grandparents are invited into school to take part in a street party on the playground, where the children will have cakes and a drink. We have also purchased a jubilee pin badge for each child as a memento of the day. Teas, coffee and cake will be available for parents and grandparents on the afternoon too.

If you are planning on joining us on the afternoon, the information below shows you the procedure we have put in place.

- 1) Please collect your child/ children from the classroom doors at 2.15pm, as you normally would at the end of the school day.
- 2) Your child will have their school bags/ coats etc with them at this time.
- 3) Please take your child onto the playground where you will be able to sit together for the street party.
- 4) Please note, that your child will be your responsibility for the rest of the afternoon. Staff will supervise children without visitors during our street party.
- 5) Teas, coffees and cakes will be available for parents and grandparents from the school kitchen.
- 6) At the end of the party, you will be able to take your child home, but please inform your child's class teacher before leaving the premises.
