

Battle Hill Primary School Protocol for January - Opening for Key Worker and Vulnerable Children

Drop off and pick up from school

Arrival time between 8.45 and 9.00 am. If you arrive after 8.55am, the gates will be locked and your child will not be able to come into school. **(Please note there will be no breakfast or after school club available)**

- Children will enter through normal allocated gate.
Year 6 children will enter through the gate near the staff car park at the rear on the school on **Bromsgrove Close**, where a member of staff will collect the children and escort them into class.
- One parent/carer will be required to line up with their child two meters apart from other families to ensure safe social distancing measures. Please **DO NOT** enter the school premises.
Y5 and Y6 children may walk home but only if written permission has been provided.
- Parents are advised to avoid public transport and instead walk, cycle or use family transport.
- Please pick up your child promptly at 3.15pm from the gate they were dropped off at.
- Groups will be allocated staff who will remain with them. Please note this may not be their normal class teacher.
- Once children are in school, they will remain in the same classroom, where they will stay with their group every day. They will sit at the same desk and be given a plastic wallet containing resources, such as pencils etc which will remain for their use only. Pupils will clean this at the end of each day.
- Children will have staggered break and lunch times and will not mix with other groups during these times. Within their groups they will still be required to social distance.
- Children may continue to bring water bottles into school
 - Lunches will be provided for those children entitled to free school meals
- Children will be required to wear school uniform

Hygiene and Behaviour	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will continue to be reminded on effective infection control, including social distancing and hygiene measures such as washing hands on arrival to school, before and after eating and after coughing or sneezing etc. • Each classroom has its own sanitising and cleaning products. Staff will be sanitising and cleaning equipment as pupils use it. • Each year group has an allocated set of toilets, with only one child at a time entering. • Pupils will wash their hands regularly throughout the day, on entering school, before/after eating, coughing or sneezing and before they leave school. • Enhanced cleaning measures have been put in place, with soft toys and toys that cannot be washed being removed from classrooms. Resources and furniture will be limited in classes. • First aid staff will wear full PPE when dealing with pupils. • Where children or any household member display any symptoms, they should NOT be brought into school and school should be advised as soon as possible. • Any child who becomes ill in school, will be self- isolated and parents/ carers contacted to pick up their child (and siblings) immediately. The child will then need to be tested and if tested negative will be allowed to return to school. However, if tested positive, they should self-isolate for 10 days and school must be advised immediately. • Any potential breaches of social distancing or challenging behaviour will result in pupils being sent home. They will not be allowed to return to school until lockdown measures have been severely restricted.
