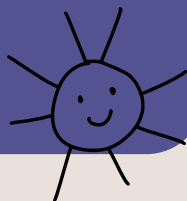


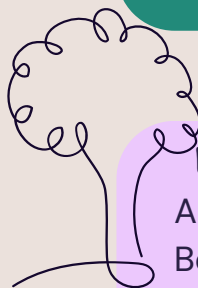

All our children at Bearwood get to experience nature, creativity and mindfulness in our expert led Forest school sessions!

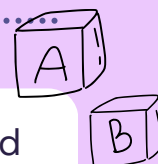

About Us

Welcome to Oak 1 & Acorn Room – the Nursery provision at Bearwood Primary & Nursery School. We provide for children who are 2 – 4 years old.

Our Nursery sessions are 9:00am – 12:00pm, 12pm – 3pm daily Monday to Friday. Doors open at 8:50am / 11:50am. Opportunity to attend 9am – 3pm.

Our time together

The Nursery session is a balance of adult led learning opportunities and children's choice of play activities. Adult led activities take advantage of our well resourced school and can take place in the classroom, outdoor learning area, computer suite, music room, library or cooking area.

Every session your child will be provided with a free piece of fruit and a drink of milk, and the opportunity to eat in a friendly social situation. We focus on teaching skills such as grating, cutting and peeling and encourage the children to use these independently during their snack time. If staying all day, a packed lunch will need to be provided.

What do we learn?

Our learning is based around the seven areas in the Early Years Curriculum.

Prime areas:

Communication and language

Developing the confidence to talk to adults and other children and a love of reading and writing.

Physical Development

Moving with confidence, using equipment carefully and safely.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Understanding their own needs, feelings and those of others.

We know that children learn best when it is exciting and relevant to them. We develop topics from the children's interests.

Specific areas

Literacy

Developing a love of reading and writing, taking the children's knowledge and questions as a starting point to engage their excitement.

Mathematics

Learning to count, recognise numbers and shapes and solve practical problems.

Understanding the world

Developing a sense of wonder and discovery, observing and asking questions.

Expressive Arts & Design

Developing imagination through role play, music, dance, drawing, painting and model making.



We assess your child's progress continuously keeping written observations, photos and examples of learning online via the Tapestry app. We welcome parental input and provide regular opportunities for you to come in and join us in our Nursery..
