For **English**, each class prepare and learn a poem to perform in an assembly to parents each term.



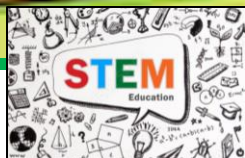
Throughout the year, different sporting coaches develop our skills and knowledge of physical activity in **PE**.



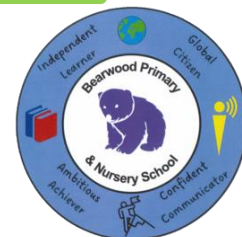
Key stage 2 have a **French** Day to apply our skills and knowledge taught through the year.



We all take part in STEM day where work in groups to learn about **science** and technology



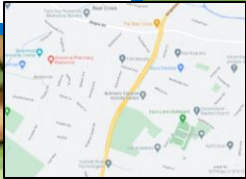
In **PE**, each year we have a visiting athlete who shares their story of how they have become successful.

For **History**, Poole museum will visit the school so we can learn about pirates and Harry Paye.



Part of being a confident communicator is to perform a play at Bearwood. We will be part of the Bearwood nativity at Christmas.



In **Science**, we visit Kingfisher barn to learn about plants and trees. It also links back to the learning we did in **Geography** about human and physical features. (£1.30)

Summer

In **Science**, we grow our own vegetables in our school allotment.



We visit the local church for harvest festival and the local vicar comes to talk to us as part of our **RE** lessons.

For our **History** topic, we learn about the Titanic and visit the museum in Southampton. (£11)



Autumn

We are actors in the school nativity. We perform, dance and sing in front of an audience.



For our **Art** lessons we visit the Russell Coates museum. (£16)



We learn about conserving water. We have a workshop from Waterwise in our **Science** lessons.



We have a visit from the Fire Service to learn about fire **safety**.

In our local **history** lessons, we learn about the Iron age in the local area and explore our 'round house' built on the field.



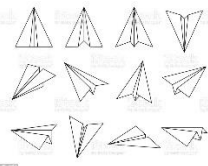

In **History**, we visit the Nothe Fort where we learn about WW2 and the local impact it had. (£14)



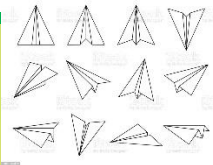
For **Geography** we visit the local beach and compare how it is now to what it was like in the past. (£10)
