A message from Mrs Emsen

Welcome back to another half term. We have lots of learning planned and excitingly our Christmas performance on 16th December at 2.30pm or 17th December at 9.30am. Tickets will be available soon.

Writing

We will continue to have daily phonics sessions when we will revisit previously taught graphemes as well as learn a variety of new graphemes.

In our writing lessons we will be studying the book Lost Species by Jess French and Daniel Long. The outcome of this will be a non-chronological report. The children will use nouns, adjectives, verbs and adverbs. They will also use conjunctions and write in the past tense.

Our second text is Little Red by Beth Woollvin. We will continue to learn to punctuate our sentences and use descriptive anguage to write a story based on traditional tales

Reading

Children who enjoy reading regularly thrive in their learning and therefore children are asked to read with an adult for 5-10 minutes every day to rehearse this skill and develop a love of reading. This could be school books, library books as well as own reading books.

Reading books will be changed once a week to allow children to develop fluency and a good understanding of the vocabulary within the book. They will read this book three times in school before it is sent home.

Maths

In maths we will be learning about addition and subtraction of two-digit numbers and using equipment such as dienes, number lines and bead strings to help us to solve mathematical problems. We will then move onto measuring length accurately using centimetres. We will finish the term with some work about creating and interpreting graphs.

RE

We are studying a Christianity unit this term. Holly 2 will be learning about incarnation, and the story of Jesus's birth. We will use this knowledge to help us to perform our Christmas play.

Art

In art Holly 2 will be looking at work by the artist Benji Davis. We will be inspired by the natural environment and use natural things we have found to develop our sketching skills.
