Writing

In writing, we will be focusing on writing to inform by creating a newspaper report and speech about based on a dystopian version of Three Little Pigs. Pupils will practise organising information into sections, using facts and technical vocabulary, and writing in clear, informative sentences. This will develop their ability to research, plan, and present information effectively.

Reading

In reading, we will be focusing on reading for pleasure by exploring a range of books, poems, and stories. Pupils will practise choosing texts that interest them, discussing their preferences, and sharing recommendations with their peers. This will develop their ability to engage with reading independently and foster a love for literature.

Maths

We will be taking part in the Fiver Challenge, a free national enterprise programme from Young Enterprise for children aged 5-11. Pupils will start their own business with a £5 pledge over four weeks, developing core skills such as problem-solving, confidence, creativity, and teamwork. They will research, create, plan, and run their business, with opportunities to enter competitions, win prizes, and feature in the Fiver Showcase.

Science

In Science, pupils will learn about electrical circuits, including how to draw and interpret circuit symbols. They will explore how components like batteries, bulbs, and switches work together to create a functioning circuit.

Music

In Music, pupils will focus on preparing for their end of year show, practising songs, and developing performance skills. They will work on timing, expression, and teamwork to deliver a confident performance.

RE

In RE, pupils will continue to learn about Akhira, focusing on role play and situational conversations. They will explore Muslim beliefs about the afterlife, judgement, and how these influence daily choices and actions.

Geography

In Geography, pupils will learn about rivers, including their features and how they shape the landscape. They will explore the water cycle, river processes, and the impact of rivers on human activity.

PE

In PE, pupils will develop their skills in athletics and football. They will build teamwork, coordination and fitness, applying these skills in a range of drills, games and competitive activities.

PSHE

In PSHE, pupils will explore growing and changing, including self-esteem, managing change, and understanding relationships. They will discuss personal development and social challenges to build confidence and resilience.
