We are delighted to be supporting the NSPCC by taking part in Number Day on **Friday 4th February 2022**.

The NSPCC need our support more than ever. By raising money, we can help to fund their vital services such as Childline – the helpline that's always there for children and young people whatever their problem or concern. Number Day is a great way to make maths fun and bring about a positive, 'can-do' attitude towards it.

On the day, children in EYFS and KS1 will take part in special maths activities from the NSPCC and KS2 will be competing in a friendly national NSPCC Times Table Rockstar battle throughout the day. This battle can also be played at home from 7:30am until 7:30pm in the evening but limited to a total of 60 minutes. For every correct answer to a multiplication or division question, your child will earn their class a point. The Times Tables Rock Stars platform will calculate the class average (the number of correct answers per pupil in the class who play during the competition hours,). Winning classes in the school and in the competition as a whole will be the ones with the highest average.

As a school, we will be taking part in 'Dress up for Digits'. Pupils are asked to wear an item of clothing with a number on it (football shirt, cap, netball shirt or even a onesie!). Or get even more creative by dressing in a maths or numbers theme. To help raise money for the NSPCC, we are asking for a suggested donation of £1, and we'd love everyone in the school to take part in this special event. Please send in your £1 donation to support NSPCC's work to your child's class teacher.
