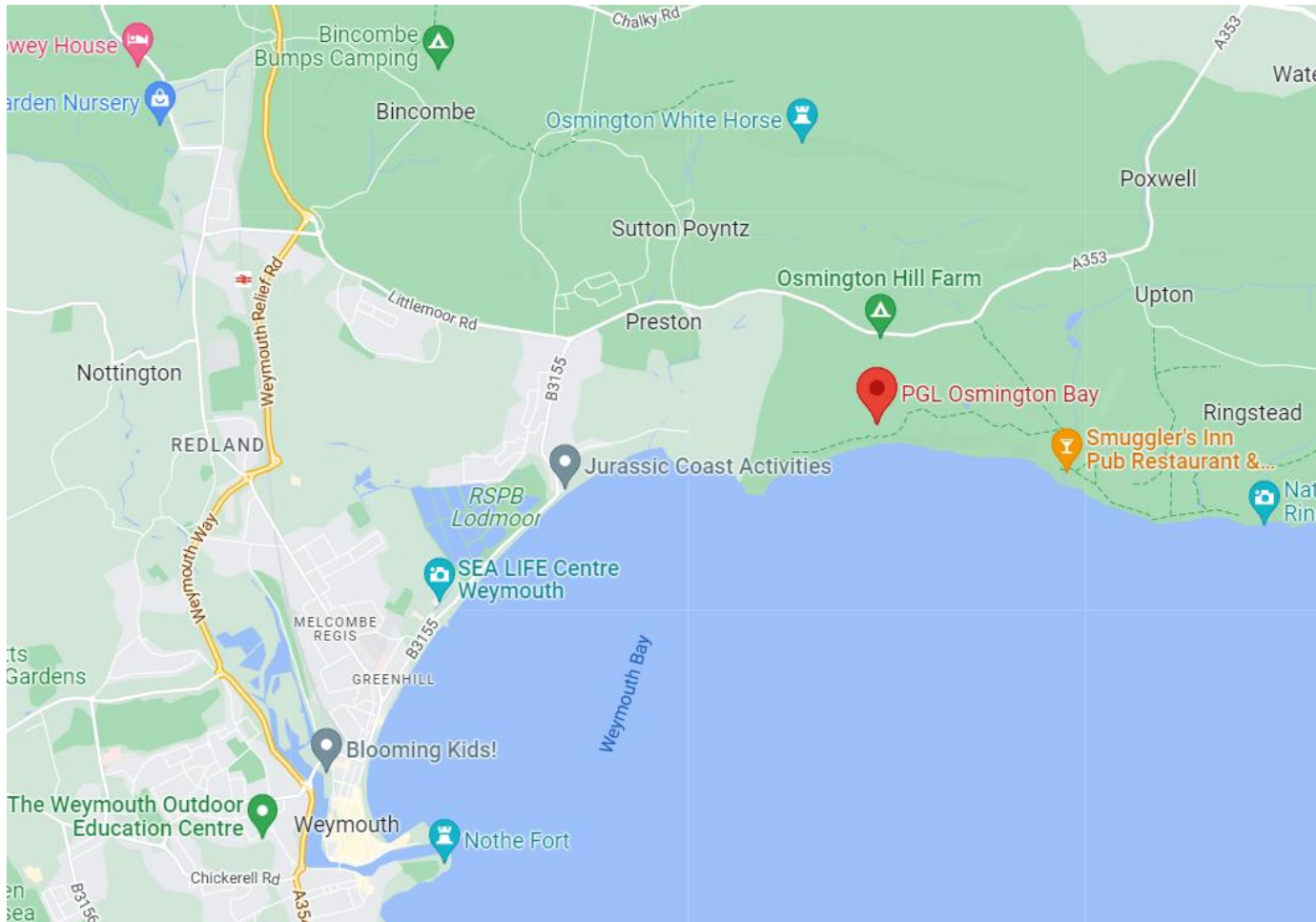

Accommodation:

The rooms are 4 people chalets consisting of bunk beds and ensuite bathrooms.
